

## **SUMMIT ACTION FUND General Information**

Saskatchewan Housing Corporation's (SHC) Summit Action Fund is designed to increase housing supply across the province. The Summit Action Fund is funded by the provincial government through the SHC, an agency of Social Services. The \$6 million investment will make it possible for stakeholders to come forward and propose creative solutions that are not currently covered by existing housing programs, facilitating innovation in the housing sector.

The fund will cover from 30 to 70 per cent of eligible project costs, or to a maximum of \$500,000.

Applicants requesting funding on projects totaling \$100,000 or more are required to submit a proposal based on the requirements set out in the request for proposal. Applicants requesting funding on projects totaling less than \$100,000 must use the application form, which can also be found on the government's website at [www.socialservices.gov.sk.ca/housing](http://www.socialservices.gov.sk.ca/housing).

Two intakes will occur, with the possibility of a third intake if total funding has not been allocated.

**Intake 1 deadline: September 1, 2011**

**Intake 2 deadline: January 16, 2012**

**Projects must be completed within two years of the approval date.**
